## Definition of a Service Dog

Under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), a Service Dog is defined as a dog that has been individually trained to do work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability. **The task(s) performed by the dog must be directly related to the person's disability.**

Emotional Support, therapy, comfort, and companion animals are not considered Service Dogs under the ADA (as they have not been trained to perform a specific job or task) and do not qualify for free pet licensing. Cats and mini pigs also do not qualify for Service Animal licensing.

## Jurisdiction Requirements/Restrictions

**Bellevue, Papillion:** Offer free licensing for seeing eye dogs and police dogs **ONLY**

**Omaha, Ralston, Springfield:** Offer free licensing for all "Service Dogs"

**Gretna, La Vista, Waterloo:** Offer free licensing for all "Service Dogs" upon owner submitting proof of this service dog being a graduate of a recognized training school
